 - Prior to driving a client to an outing in the community, please ensure that you have an updated and signed passenger liability waiver on NPA.



Further, the big news is R is talking lots more by leaps and bounds. She's becoming more aware of things we ask her and her responses are so amazing.


My husband and I thank you all at Connections so much for her success in her journey.

Point Defiance Zoo and Aquarium


